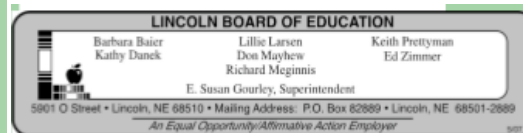

The Lincoln Southwest Media Center will provide the following resources on scheduled Saturdays:

Media Staff: Ms. Alyx Knight or Ms. Laurie Logsdon, LSW Media Specialists, will be able to assist you with locating and accessing resources, utilizing software and hardware for school projects, and preparing bibliographies.

Collections in Print

The media center houses a collection of more than 17,000 fiction, non-fiction, and reference books. Books can be checked out for a period of three weeks; reference books may be checked out overnight.

LSW subscribes to a wide variety of periodicals including newspapers, professional journals, and popular press items. Periodicals may be checked out for one week.

E-Resources

LSW is the city-wide leader in subscription databases for access to academic articles, electronic reference, and student tools. All may be accessed from home as well as from school. (Please pick up passwords in the Media Center).

Guidelines for Saturday

- Q:** Do I have to arrive at 8:00 on Saturday morning, or can I show up later in the morning?
- A:** We are open from 8:00 – 12:00; you can enter anytime between these hours. Computer users will be asked to save approximately 10 minutes before closing; make certain you arrive soon enough to get your work completed!
- Q:** Can we complete group work during this time?
- A:** Saturday morning will be a great time to work with a team on projects requiring E-Resources or reference books, specialized software such as Garage Band or iMovie, or to rehearse your presentations.
- Q:** Can I use the computers to cruise the internet on Saturdays?
- A:** The guidelines regarding computer use will be the same on Saturday as during the school day. In addition, as a courtesy to our other patrons, we ask that you take your cell phone calls outside the media center.
